Presiding Commissioner Ted Findley brought the meeting to order at 9:05 am.

Commissioner Tyler Paxson made a motion to approve the minutes and agenda. Commissioner Regan Nonneman seconded. All in favor, motion carried.

Treasurer Linda Brown was out sick, but she left the weekly financial statement for review.

Worth County EMD, Gene Auten reported that he will be attending the Region H Quarterly meeting today. Gene met with the Fire and Ambulance Districts to get a good inventory of radios and a list of things they might need over the next few years. The Worth County Fire District would like to move their radio licenses to Worth County's tower and repeater. Clerk Owens presented a request from Fire Chief Ben Fletcher to share the repeater. There is space on the sheriff's license for 100 radios. The Fire Department would share the cost with the county and ambulance district. The commissioners agreed to the proposal. Clerk Owens will let Fletcher know of the decision. Auten reported that upon further inspection of the generator they found that the low oil pressure light stayed on. The generaro also started out running fine, but then didn't run smoothly after running for a while. The commissioners advised him to take it to A2Z Enterprises and have Jud Summers look at it. There will be a tornado drill on Tuesday the 7th. Gene will participate in the drill and sound the sirens in the county. Commissioner Regan Nonneman made a motion to adjourn at 11:05. Commissioner Tyler Paxson seconded. All in favor, motion carried.

Economic Development.

Courtney Blankenship opened her beauty shop and had an open house on March 3rd. Gene is helping a business owner that is planning to put up a building for his office. Auten compiled a journal with all the abandoned houses and buildings in town. He asked Carolyn Hardy, County Assessor to look the information over and enter assessed valuations for each one. He will then have Collector Julie Tracy note any back taxes due on each property. This is the first phase of cleaning up Worth County project that Gene is working to complete. The City put up \$5000 for the project and the county will loan equipment for whatever they need. The Progress Organization will help with the cleanup project as well.

Russ Love, and Scott Stevens, Bridge Engineers from MoDot came in to discuss this year's bridge inspections. They were really impressed with the county on the repairs of the 2 bridges that were noted last year during the inspection. He also noted the requested beam repairs had been completed. Russ said that overall the county's bridge look good.

Commissioner Tyler Paxson asked Clerk Owens to insert CR 52 in the Brush Spreadsheet. The road does qualify for brush removal.

Commissioner Regan Nonneman made a motion to adjourn at 10:55. Commissioner Tyler Paxson seconded. All in favor, motion carried.
