Called to order 9 a.m. Presiding Commissioner Findley appointed Miranda Lyle to take minutes in the absence of County Clerk Roberta Owens.

Commissioner Paxson made motion to approve agenda, minutes and to pay bills and payroll. Seconded by Commissioner Nonneman.

Commissioners Findley, Paxson, Nonneman; Treasurer Linda Brown, and Deputy Clerk Miranda Lyle signed new signature cards for the banking account. Deputy Treasurer Lori Wimer and County Clerk Roberta Owens will sign later.

EMD Gene Auten presented his report. Full day training on April 29th still has some vacant seats for anyone interested. Meal will be provided by Sheridan Fire Protection District. Half-day training on May 13th has some vacant seats for anyone interested. Auten is working with the fire protection districts to reprogram radios. The new Region H EMD will be in place by the end of April. The position has been vacant since Cory Sloan left in the fall of 2016. There is a grant available through the State Homeland Security Program. Auten is reviewing requirements and may apply.

Linda Brown presented bills and payroll along with the treasurer's report.

Road and Bridge supervisor Jim Fletchall reported an 8'x80' tube near David Seat's will need to be replaced. 3 or 4 plastic tubes around the county have failed, one by Kevin Hiatt's on county road 245 included. Some tubes were washed out by Chris Spainhower's which the crew managed. Jim is checking the right of way for Dennis Davis for purposes of brush clearing. Commissioner Nonneman requested that Jason Rinehart be added to the list of bulldozer operators in the event someone calls the county needing dozer work information. County road 51 plus the road south of Bill Grabb's will be added to the tax rock list. An additional road near Butch Thomas's farm will need additional work before being added to the list. Sweeps will be shipped as soon as the county check is received. Commissioner Nonneman requested that the work at Betty Smith's be finished. Trees were reported in the right of way. It was determined that the trees are within the limits of the Village of Allendale along Kevin Harding's property.

Commissioners reviewed concrete bids and door bids from Coffelt Masonry and Maryville Glass and Lock for work on the west and north entrances. Motion by Commissioner Paxson, seconded by Commissioner Nonneman to approve both bids and to have work begin as soon as possible.

Regional Council of Governments called to remind Commissioners of a meeting [tomorrow](#) at noon in Maryville. Commissioners Findley and Paxson will attend.
