Road & Bridge Foreman Jim Fletchall reported that the crew finished with the bridge near Bobbie Rineharts and Betty Smith's ditch had been completed. Upcoming projects include working in Denver on the road tube on the truck route, tubes near Chris Spainhower's, rock hauling near Commissioner Findley's, tubes near Snead's property, tubes on County Road 70, inspection of tube on county road 50, grading on Mark Rush's road, and tubes near Kevin Meek's. Commissioner Paxson discussed Senate Bill 283.

Deputy Clerk Lyle reported for Clerk Owens. Fall patron rock money is due [October 23](#) with a starting haul date of [November 1](#), a MODOT survey on long-range planning was completed by the Commission, the RSVP for the pipeline meeting was completed, and a letter from the county attorney was reviewed.
