Commissioner Findley called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m.

Commissioner Regan Nonneman made a motion to approve the agenda and minutes. Commissioner Tyler Paxson seconded. All in favor, motion carried.

Treasurer Linda Brown presented the weekly financial statement, payroll and bills.

Commissioner Tyler Paxson made a motion to approve the bills and payroll. Commissioner Regan Nonneman seconded. All in favor, motion carried.

Nodaway County Prosecuting Attorney, Robert Rice stopped by to tell the Commissioners about a new Victims Advocacy program that is in place for Nodaway, Gentry, Atchison, and Worth Counties. The prosecuting attorneys in the area wrote a grant to fund having an advocate for victims of a crime. Karen Kepka has accepted the position. She will be available to any adult that is a victim of a crime in the 4 county region. Nodaway county fronts the cost and then is reimbursed from the grant. If a person in Worth County would like more information they can contact the Prosecuting Attorney's office at the courthouse.

Worth County EMD Gene Auten reported that they made progress on the house demolition started by the Revitalization Committee. The house has been torn down, and they are finishing up on the dirt work. It has cost a little under \$1000 for the project. The city set aside \$5000 for the revitalization project in Grant City. The county donated the equipment for the demolition. Volunteers, including Commissioner Paxson completed the work. Once the work everything is done the property will be sold. Gene plans to start another project soon.

Road and Bridge Foreman Jim Fletchall reported

- a tube problem on CR 112/195th Lane. It has a cement headwall that is crumbling, so they will need to either replace the headwall or put in a new longer tube.
- The excavator will still be at the demolition site for a couple of days if Tyler wants to work on the property more.
- Need tires for the backhoe.

A representative from Phillips Insurance Co came to share information about their health care coverage with the commissioners. They commissioners agreed to have them come at a later date to get quotes on health insurance for the county employees.

Commissioner Regan Nonneman made a motion to adjourn at 11:30. Commissioner Tyler Paxson seconded. All in favor, motion carried.
