Gene Auten, Worth County EMD reported that he received a call from the Inspector of the Emergency Sirens. He is planning on inspecting some of the sirens in the county.

He will be attending a Pipeline Association of Missouri (PAM) exercise in Maryville this Thursday the 8th. There will be a regional meeting in Cameron this month.

On the Economic Developer side, Gene reported that he had found some funding for the SSM project. He will attend a Nursing Home board meeting to discuss the options with them. And see if they are interested in doing this project. Discussed the Solid Waste Grant. They will apply for a brush cutting attachment for the excavator instead of a skid steer.

County Attorney Brett Hurst stopped by and reported to the commissioners that the County Brush Ordinance and Statute are in compliance after a question was brought up about the language in the statute. In another matter, he will be sending a letter to a land owner that is threatening to sue and explain that the commissioners are correct in cutting the brush as explained. Mr. Hurst requested and received permission from the commissioners to be included in the Opioid law suite coming up.

Linda Mattson and Meghann Kosman from the Children and Family Center in Maryville stopped in to share information about their services and what is available free of charge for Worth County residents. They offer support for victims of Domestic Violence and Sexual Assault free of charge. They have a 24 hours hotline, 24 hour shelter for victims that are in immediate danger.
