Presiding Commissioner Findley called the meeting to order at 9:00

Commissioner Regan Nonneman made a motion to approve the minutes and agenda. Commissioner Tyler Paxson seconded. All in favor, motion carried.

Clerk Owens presented the weekly financial sheet, in the absence of Treasurer Linda Brown.

County EMD/Economic Developer Gene Auten reported he has \$100 toward the Textcaster bill. The commissioners voted to accept the \$100 and pay the rest of the bill out of County Revenue. Then add it to the budget for next year. It is a good program and helps to get people notified in the case of an emergency. So Gene shouldn't have to get donations for it every year for it. Gene has been working to get items for Fire Prevention Week for the Fire depts.. He is working on the application for the Brownfield Assessments for the lots on the west side of the square, to see if they can be used for a building for Mission Possible.

Road and Bridge Foreman Jim Fletchall reported that there was a 4.5 inch rain on the Lynch Bottom that washed out a tank car tube. He will put a head wall on it to help keep it from washing out again. Commissioner Findley reported that there is water washing over the road on Poplar Ave. Fletchall also reported that he is looking for hay for mulching on future projects.

County Attorney Keith Shieber arrived to the meeting. Commissioner Regan Nonneman made a motion to go into closed session at 10:00am pursuant to RSMo 610.021(1) Commissioner Tyler Paxson seconded. Clerk Owens presented the commissioners with a new 911 law that went into effect on August 28th, 2018.

RSMo 190.460.5 says The prepaid wireless emergency telephone service charge imposed by this section shall be in addition to any other tax, fee, surcharge, or other charge imposed by this state, any political subdivision of this state, or any intergovernmental agency for 911 funding purposed, except that such prepaid wireless emergency telephone service charge shall be charged in lieu of, and not imposed in addition to, any tax imposed under section 190.292 or 190.335.

*RSMo 190460.6 The provision s of this section shall become effective unless the governing body of a county or city adopts an ordinance, order, rule, resolution. Or regulation by at least a two-thirds vote prohibiting the charge established under this section from becoming effective in the county or city at least forty-five days prior to the effective date of this section *. If the governing body does adopt such ordinance, order, rule, resolution, or regulation by at least a two-thirds vote , the change shall not be collected and the county or city shall not be allowed to obtain funds from the Missouri 911 service trust fund that are remitted to the fund under the charge established under this section . The Missouri 911 service board shall, by September 1, 2018, notify all counties and cities of the implementation of the charge established under this section, and the procedures set forth under this subsection for prohibits the charge from becoming effective *This section became effective August 28, 2018; however, the service charge does not begin until January 1, 2019, in accordance with subsections 2 and 3 of this section.*
